

OSU Skydiving Registration Contract

In order to register for the Summer 2010 Introduction to Skydiving Class, you must sign and submit this contract confirming that you acknowledge and understand the following statements:

1. In order to pass this class, you must attend **all class sessions** listed on the syllabus and on your receipt. All emails or inquiries requesting an exception to this rule will go unanswered by the instructional staff.
2. You will not be permitted to arrive late to any class session or to leave early.
3. You cannot register for this class if it overlaps with another course on your schedule. Additional meetings of other classes (e.g. testing periods) are not an acceptable excuse for missing this class.
4. Additional work outside of class (via Carmen content and quizzes) will be required for some jumpers. If these assignments are not completed by the due date it is possible that you will not be able to jump on the scheduled date.
5. You are required to take the provided class transportation to and from the dropzone on your specific jump date. While others (e.g. friends or family) are permitted to come and observe your experience, you will not be permitted to leave the dropzone early or at any point during the jump day. All emails or inquiries requesting an exception to this rule will go unanswered by the instructional staff.
6. It is possible that we are at the dropzone for more than twelve (12) hours. We understand that this may be frustrating to those in the first and last groups to jump, but we require your compliance. We appreciate your lack of "when will we leave?" inquiries.
7. On jump day, most of your instructors will be constantly occupied with commitments to other students. If you have any inquiries that require attention you are asked to contact the Facilitator who will be identified that morning.
8. All instruction will be given in English. If English is not your first language, an inability to translate quickly may result in severe injury or death. If at any time you or the instructional staff feels that language is a barrier to instruction, you will be required to delay your jump until a more appropriate time.
9. You are not guaranteed the opportunity to skydive simply by registering for this class. If the instructional staff feels that jumping will compromise the safety of you and/or your instructors, your jump will be rescheduled or cancelled. This will not affect your final grade in the class.
10. You do not have to jump to pass this class.
11. Evidence of current or recent intoxication will result in you relinquishing your opportunity to jump that day.
12. If weather prevents us from jumping, you will receive a raincheck on your dropzone account to jump at your convenience. No payments will be refunded. Tandems can utilize their rainchecks anytime before the end of the year. AFF students must jump within 30 days or you may be subject to a small retraining fee.
13. You will be required to read and sign multiple waivers from both Start Skydiving, LLC and Ohio State University. These waivers will be provided at the first class section. The instructional staff cannot provide legal interpretation of these documents and all questions must be directed at legal counsel that you personally acquire.

I concede that I understand the statements above and agree to comply with these statements in order to register and participate in EDU PAES 139.14: Introduction to Skydiving.
